D 4. I need a personal protection order because: Explain what has happened (attach separate sheets).
 On 6/18/22, I, Monique Owens, was aggressively approached by Harvey Curley, my co-worker, at the Eastpointe High school parking lot during the Gratiot Cruise event in Eastpointe. Harvey Curley ran towards me with his hands in my faced and started cursing at me which caused me to be in immediate fear, panic and intimidation. The fear of my safety was so much at stake I could barely move because I was in shock. I screamed for help from Eric Lloyd to assist me with backing him off of me. Harvey Curley continued to put his hands in my face while screaming even when asked to step back and put his hands down. Harvey Curley refused to comply only to come closer and become more aggressive. I felt that he was going to assault me physically and cause me harm. Eric Lloyd tried to calm him down but he continued to approach me. I ran immediately up the stairs and hollered for additional assistance from the Eastpointe Police Chaplains Pastor Rush, Pastor Kevin Lancaster, and Pastor James Friedman. The Chaplains immediately ran down the stairs to stop Harvey Curley from further approach and tried to control him and calm him down. See Police Report

- E 5. I make this petition under the authority of MCL 600.2950a(1) and ask the court to grant a personal protection order prohibiting the respondent from
- a. stalking me as defined by MCL 750.411h and MCL 750.411i, which includes but is not limited to
- following me or appearing within my sight.
 - appearing at my workplace or residence.
 - approaching or confronting me in a public place or on private property.
 - entering onto or remaining on property owned, leased, or occupied by me.
 - sending mail or other communications to me.
 - contacting me by telephone.
 - placing an object on or delivering an object to property owned, leased, or occupied by me.
 - threatening to kill or physically injure me.
 - purchasing or possessing a firearm.
 - other: attending events where I will be present
- b. posting a message through the use of any medium of communication, including the Internet or a computer or any electronic medium, pursuant to MCL 750.411s.

F 6. I request an ex parte order because immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage will occur between now and a hearing or because notice itself will cause irreparable injury, loss, or damage before the order can be entered.
